This year, the City of Miami Springs and the Curtiss Mansion Foundation are proud to launch the Glenn Curtiss & June Bug Legacy Memorial, an extraordinary Centennial art project designed by local sculptor Natalie Plasencia.



Meet the Artist: Natalie Plasencia

A Cuban American sculptor, Natalie Plasencia approaches art as a spiritual practice, each piece a reflection of purpose and soul. Her work blends fine arts and social advocacy, weaving stories that inspire and uplift communities.

As a proud Miami Springs resident and member of the Woman's Club, Natalie's artistry is deeply personal. Together with her husband, architect Juan Calvo, she has contributed to preserving our community's heritage and beauty.

GLENN CURTISS & JUNE BUG LEGACY MEMORIAL

The Project

The Memorial will feature two remarkable pieces:

The Glenn Curtiss Monument — a life-sized bronze of Curtiss, 6'3" tall, poised on a 3'2" base, surrounded by bronze relief panels celebrating his legacy as aviation pioneer, military innovator, motorcycle champion, and city builder.

The June Bug Monument — a walk-through installation, 42'6" long \times 12' wide \times 6' high, inspired by Curtiss's historic aircraft. Visitors will step into an immersive, living timeline of his life and achievements.


Together, they form a Centennial tribute worthy of our founder's vision and our community's next century.
